The Stockholm Convention Persistent Organic Pollutants Review Committee (POPRC) reviews and updates the Stockholm Convention's list of Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) which details the substances that are eliminated, restricted, or subject to limitations. KYZEN monitors this list in conjunction with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 on persistent organic pollutants and The Persistent Organic Pollutants Regulations 2007.

KYZEN Corporation declares that substances, processes, and materials used or produced during the manufacturing of its products:

- Do not intentionally contain POPs;
- Do not involve laboratory-scale research using POPs;
- Do not use equipment containing POPs;
- Do not exceed the limits defined for unintentional trace contaminants of POPs.
